ORDINANCE # 28
AN ORDINANCE FOR BOAT RAMPS LOCATED IN LAKE CITY

According to County records there are two BOAT RAMPS located in Lake City:

- 1) Located off Lakeview Drive at the entrance of Lake City
- 2) Located at the end of Mesquite Dr.

The named BOAT RAMPS are for LAKE CITY RESIDENTS ONLY. The resident must have a boat ramp pass issued to them before using the ramp. The card that is issued to them must be visible on their dash when using the boat ramp for compliance officers to see.

The boat ramp pass must be issued to the property owner: You will need to provide your driver's license or proof of residence before issuance. **The boat ramp pass must have the city seal to be valid.**

There is a sign posted at each boat ramp explaining the boat ramp rules. **The sign is your warning.**

There will be no other warnings issued for misuse of the boat ramps, you will be given a citation and will have to appear in the Municipal Court of Lake City and pay the assessed fine.


If you are a resident of Lake City you may let your guest use your boat ramp pass but it is your responsibility that your card is displayed in their vehicle.

There will be **NO PARKING SIGNS** posted in certain areas; under no circumstances should the said boat ramps be blocked. If your boat needs worked on you must remove it from the water to do so. Don't block road, you must leave room for vehicles to have a turn around, to launch their boat. **There will be no tolerance of this you will be given a citation.**

There will be no tying boat up overnight next to the boat ramp. Only tie up for loading and unloading your boat.

If you are given a citation you will have to appear on the date designated at the Municipal Court in Lake City.
