

**Addendum to Ordinance 23**  
**CITY PASS FOR EMERGENCY OR NATURAL DISASTER**

**PREAMBLE**

The City of Lake City is continuing to development and maintain the safety and well-being of the residents. In order to do so, the city would like for each resident to complete a form with vital information we may need in case of a natural disaster or other types of emergencies.

**ORDAINING CLAUSE**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF LAKE CITY, TEXAS

**SECTION I**

**AUTHORIZATION**

The mayor or his/her designee is hereby authorized and directed to implement the applicable provisions of this ordinance upon his/her determination that such action is necessary to protect the public welfare and safety of the residents and to protect personal property within the city limits.

**SECTION II**

**APPLICATION**

The application of this ordinance shall apply to residents, renters/lessee and/or landlords. Once a city pass form is completed you will be issued a decal to be placed on your windshield. In case of a natural disaster or other types of emergencies this decal will allow you to have access into the community once the law enforcement has opened up roads to allow residents back into neighborhood to evaluate the damage to their personal property. Without the decal you may experience a delay to get to your property.

**SECTION III**

**EFFECTIVE DATE**

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and publication as required by law.

**SECTION IV**

**SEVERABILITY**

If for any reason any section of this Ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by final judgement of a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect any other section of this Ordinance for it is the intent of this City that each of such be given full force and intent for its purpose.

**SECTION V**

**PENALTY**

No violation will apply to this Ordinance as this is volunteered information for their protection only.
