Amendment – Redefine complete original ordinance 8/16/2022

**ORDINANCE 36  
NOISE ORDINANCE**

**PREAMBLE**

The Residents of Lake City enjoy the quiet of living in a small community and enjoy the pleasures of outdoors. The Council has taken measures to insure the residents and their guests are not disturbed by loud noises.

**ORDAINING CLAUSE**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF LAKE CITY, TEXAS,

**SECTION 1 AUTHORIZATION**

The Mayor or his/her designee is hereby authorized and directed to implement the applicable provisions of this Ordinance upon his/her determination that such implementation is necessary to protect the public welfare and safety of the residents and their guests.

**SECTION 2 APPLICATION**

The application of this Ordinance shall apply to all persons, residents and their guests, visitors, and renters within the city of Lake City.

A person may not make noise or use sound equipment in public between 10PM and 6AM Monday through Thursday and 12AM and 6AM Friday and Saturday except during holidays that produces sound or vibration audible beyond the property line of a resident. Sound equipment means a loud speaker, public address system, amplification system, or other sound producing devices..

**EFFECTIVE DATE**

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and publication as required by law.

**SECTION 4 SEVERABILITY**

If for any reason any section of this Ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by first judgment of a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect any other section of this Ordinance for it is the intent of this City that each of such be given full force and intent for its purpose.

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**SECTION 5 PENALTY**


A violation of this Ordinance can result in a fine plus court costs if the court orders. The penalties are:

- 1st Offense Warning
- 2nd Offense \$500.00 plus court costs

If an offense is the result of the actions of a resident's guest(s) or tenant(s) of rental property located within the city limits of Lake City the city may hold the resident or landlord of the tenant(s) responsible for not having the guest (s) or tenant(s) comply with said ordinance.
