Prohibiting Parking Large Vehicles on City Property

ORDINANCE NUMBER

16

AN ORDINANCE OF LAKE CITY, TEXAS PROHIBITING THE PARKING OF CERTAIN TYPES OF VEHICLES ON THE SHOULDERS AND RIGHT-OF-WAYS ON STREETS IN LAKE CITY AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATIONS.

WHEREAS, the streets of Lake City are narrow and the pavement fragile, particularly at the edges, and

WHEREAS, the shoulders are unpaved, often narrow and frequently dipping steeply to drainage ditches of varying depths, and

WHEREAS, restriction of passage along the streets by the parking of large vehicles poses a threat to the safety of other vehicles and their passengers,

NOW THEREFORE: BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF LAKE CITY, TEXAS:


SECTION 1. No vehicle of the type commonly known as an 18-wheeler, either the entire vehicle or the tractor and/or trailer thereof, and no vehicle commonly known as a tank truck, designed and equipped for the transport of flammable liquid, may be parked at any time on the shoulders or right-of-ways of the streets of the Township of Lake City.

SECTION 2. The owner and/or the operator of such a vehicle parked in violation of this Ordinance may be summoned to appear in the appropriate court-at-law, and upon being found guilty of such violation, may be assessed such penalty as the court deems appropriate.


SECTION 3. If any part of this ordinance be held invalid for any reason, then that fact shall not invalidate the entire ordinance, but the balance thereof shall remain in full force and effect.
